This was essentially because the minimum lot size to enter the market was in excess of \$10,000. As trading the financial markets is becoming more and more popular to individual investors, more affordable instruments are being created to lower the cost of entering the market. Commodity CFDs and Eminis are some examples of instruments available to traders with smaller investment portfolios allowing them to participate in the commodity market as well.





More on Crude Oil.

Crude oil is one of the world's most heavily traded commodities making it a fast moving and highly liquid market. Crude Oil's price is influenced by a variety of factors such as standard supply and demand to war and political unrest which provide traders numerous trading opportunities.

You can gain exposure to crude oil in a variety of ways such as via Commodity CFDs, ETFs, Forex and Futures contracts.
